***DECREE OF DISSOLUTION
OF MARRIAGE***

Petitioners

This matter was heard before the Magistrate on the ____ day of _____, 20____
on the petition for dissolution of marriage filed herein. Both parties appeared and responded
under oath to inquiries by the court. Upon the testimony presented, the Magistrate finds that the
parties appeared within the time required by law; residency was established; the parties were
married as set forth in their petition; _____ children were born of or adopted by these
parties; and the parties voluntarily entered a separation agreement that accounts for their
property and, if applicable, the allocation of parental rights and responsibilities. The Magistrate
further finds that the parties desire their marriage to be terminated.

The Magistrate therefore recommends and the Court hereby **ORDERS** that the marriage now existing between _____ (Husband) and _____ (Wife) is hereby terminated and dissolved, and both parties are released from all obligations arising from that marriage except as set forth in this decree.

The Magistrate further recommends and the Court hereby **ORDERS** that the separation agreement of the parties, a copy of which is attached to this decree and marked Exhibit A to Decree, is incorporated herein as the Order of the Court, and both parties shall fully comply with its terms.

The Magistrate further recommends and the Court hereby **ORDERS** that the court costs incurred in this proceeding shall be deducted from the deposit made with any excess costs to be paid by _____.

Petitioner-Wife, whose date of birth is _____ is restored to her former name of _____.

The parties have, by signing this Decree of Dissolution below, agreed that the Magistrate does not have to issue a separate Magistrate's Decision explaining the recommendations, that they both give up any right to object to the recommendations outlined above, and consent to this Decree of Dissolution acting as both the Magistrate's Decision and Decree relating to their petition for dissolution of their marriage.
